1. Agenda

2. Update on Process of Sale

Provost – Tonight is the second of three executive sessions to meet with potential partners and learn more about their bids. The first was June 14. We will meet with two firms tonight and two more firms on June 28. We are still on course to bring forward finalists to the City Council on July 10. At that point, the council will take over to vet and decide how to move forward. It is my hope that the BTAB will be delivering the names, Letters of Intent, and a ranking of our recommendations. I feel any guidance and information we can pass up to the Council will be helpful and I encourage BTAB members to attend that City Council meeting. Councilor Knodell, could you speak to the meeting from Monday night?

Knodell – On Monday, June 19, I held an informational meeting on alternative models for business. that was recorded by Channel 17 should anyone be interested in viewing it. We hosted Roberta MacDonald from Cabot Creamery Cooperative and Ken Merritt of Merritt and Merritt. About 20 people were there for a good conversation and as appropriate, I will offer information to this group that I learned from that session. I would also like to add that there will be an update on the Process of Sale for BT at the City Council meeting on June 26.
