Resolved by the City Council of the City of Burlington, as follows:	

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City of Burlington's sale-leaseback arrangement with Blue Water Holdings That

- (BWH) and lawsuit settlement with Citibank, the City intends to seek potential purchasers of the Burlington
- 3 Telecom (BT) system; and

WHEREAS, the City has a significant investment in BT's success, both its own \$16.9 million financial investment and its interests in ensuring affordable, effective, and responsive fiber optic services for its citizens; and

WHEREAS, to ensure that both the financial and service interests are addressed, the City has committed to the Public Service Board and the citizens of Burlington to engage in a public process that will determine the criteria by which the City can choose an appropriate sale transaction;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council approves the process recommended by the Burlington Telecom Advisory Board (BTAB) as follows:

- At the BTAB's October 21 meeting, Terry Dorman will frame and discuss the terms currently established in the BWH and Citibank agreements, as well as the market conditions and other factors that may affect the criteria.
- A public educational meeting with representatives from US Ignite and other communities with successful fiber optic infrastructure will be held on October 29, 2015;
- Two public meetings of the BTAB will then be held in November, after the public educational meeting, to accept public input and solicit comments for establishing the criteria. The first will be at the regularly scheduled BTAB meeting on November 11 at 5:30 pm in Contois, and the second is proposed for November 18 at noon (to reach those not available in the evening).
- In addition, the Administration will work on establishing an online tool for comments and other resources for collecting information from members of the public in addition to the two public meetings.
- At the BTAB's December meeting, the board members will prepare a recommendation to be presented to the City Council. The BTAB will then hold a public meeting in early January to review that draft recommendation. The recommendation will then be presented (as revised based on public comments) to the Council for approval at its January 25 meeting.
