Provost: The City Council had a work session on the BT Criteria of Sale report. I welcome feedback from BTAB as to whether it should be discussed in an Executive Session. Additionally, there is an issue regarding a specific BT Commercial customer to be addressed and a public discussion would be detrimental to BT's competitive advantage.

Councilor Knodell: I have prepared a resolution for April 25 City Council agenda to adopt the criteria as written. The Council received and discussed criteria in their March meeting and had a work session on March 21 regarding the process and timeline of the sale. The work session was held in Executive Session at the advice of City Attorney because it would be detrimental to BT's competitive advantage to make this information public. My recommendation is to bring the BTAB up to speed on the City Council's work session in Executive Session.
